PREPARE FOR WILDFIRE NEIGHBORHOOD CHIPPING

Individual homeowners must register at coswildfireready.org (select "Prepare", then "Neighborhood Chipping Program"), by calling (719)385-7493 or emailing csfdwildfiremitigationsectionsmb@coloradosprings.gov. Piles must be curbside by 8 am on Monday for your region's chipping week. To find out your region, select "Learn Your Region" on coswildfireready.org.

PREPARE FOR WILDFIRE NEIGHBORHOOD CHIPPING

CHIPPING ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Your neighborhood must be within the City of Colorado Springs Wildland Urban Interface. Find your address on the Wildfire Risk Map: https://bit.ly/coswuimap
- Participants MUST attend a neighborhood or town hall meeting or have a FREE onsite consultation before their scheduled chipping period

CHIPPING REQUESTS

- Individual homeowners must register to participate EVERY year for EVERY chipping period offered in their neighborhood. To register:

- We ONLY accept woody limbs and branches up to 9 inches in diameter
- We ONLY accept properly stacked piles
- We do NOT accept construction or building materials, nails, wire
- We do NOT accept grass clippings, bags of leaves, trash, weeds, yuccas, root wads, dirt, or rocks

PILE GUIDELINES

- Piles must be stacked curbside by 8:00 a.m. Monday morning on your designated chipping block
- Please limit pile size to 5'x5'x5'. There is no limit as to the number of piles along the curb
- Piles must be within 5 feet of the roadway
- Piles must be stacked neatly with cut ends facing the road
- Do not tie or band piles

REMEMBER

- PILES STACKED INCORRECTLY WILL NOT BE PICKED UP
- Addresses not registered WILL NOT BE PICKED UP
- Do not combine piles with neighbors or haul in from other neighborhoods
- Chipping will occur during the 1-2 weeks following the listed date
- Piles will be picked up by the end of the chipping block

Wildfire Mitigation Cost-Share Stipend Program

Stipend Guidelines:

- The cost-share stipend program is intended to reduce the wildfire risk to homes in the wildland urban interface (WUI) with hazardous vegetation within the first thirty feet (30') around the structure or ancillary building.
- Any hazardous vegetation (coniferous trees/shrubs with high resin and oil content, Gambel Oak, or any
 hazardous vegetation that is dead/dying) within the first thirty feet (30') of the structure or ancillary
 building must be removed before any other work can be completed.
- If the first thirty feet (30') has been properly mitigated, work can be extended beyond thirty feet (30').
- Deciduous trees or trees with high moisture content may be removed if half of the tree is dead and is
 posing a threat to the structure or ancillary building.
- This is not a grant award, but a dollar-for-dollar match up to \$500 per household, and can only be used
 once per household, per grant cycle (12 months). Please note that these funds are first come, first served.
- The Colorado Springs Fire Department (CSFD) Wildfire Mitigation Section <u>cannot</u> reimburse residents for work that has already been completed.
- The CSFD Wildfire Mitigation Section will <u>not</u> "landscape" or maintain your property- any work being conducted <u>must</u> follow the mitigation guidelines listed in this document.
- The CSFD Wildfire Mitigation Section does <u>not</u> cover stump grinding, vegetation replacement, or mulch replacement.

Stipend Process:

- Homeowners must choose a licensed and insured tree service from the list of <u>approved</u> companies.
 Please visit: https://www.coswildfireready.org/defensible-space for the list of tree services. If you cannot access the list of tree services, please call 719-385-7348 for the list.
- Once a tree service is chosen you <u>must</u> contact Bailey Horton to schedule a walkthrough of your property
 with the tree service company of your choice, and a CSFD Wildfire Mitigation representative. A
 walkthrough of your property is <u>required</u> prior to any work being done.
- Each participant <u>must</u> sign a stewardship agreement that explains responsibilities, obligations, and duties
 of the resident and the City of Colorado Springs.
- Each participant <u>must</u> sign the CSFD Wildfire Mitigation Cost-Share Stipend paperwork. This document is
 an agreement between the resident and the tree contractor on the work that will be done on the
 property.
- After the walkthrough and the required paperwork is signed, the homeowner is able to schedule the
 discussed work to be completed with the tree service that was chosen.
- Once the work is finished the tree service will invoice the homeowner and the CSFD Wildfire Mitigation Section separately. Each party will pay the amount that was agreed upon during the walkthrough. The homeowners will <u>not</u> be reimbursed if they pay the full amount for the work.
